## **Hudak Discusses Ideas to Improve Public Safety and Support Victims**



### **NEWS:**

QUEEN'S PARK – Ontario PC Leader Tim Hudak and members of the Ontario PC Caucus hosted a roundtable discussion with representatives from a number of public safety groups to hear their ideas and concerns for keeping Ontario's streets safe, supporting victims of crime and protecting families and seniors.

Hudak also invited attendees to participate in the Ontario PC Caucus survey – the largest survey of its kind in Ontario – at [www.HaveYourSayOntario.ca](http://www.HaveYourSayOntario.ca).

In addition to asking respondents questions about what form of tax relief would work best for them and which government services are their top priority, the survey asks for input on actions that can be taken to help fight crime and make Ontario families to feel safe and protected in their neighbourhoods.

- Ten public safety groups attended the roundtable meeting along with Ontario PC Caucus members: Garfield Dunlop, MPP Simcoe North; Ted Chudleigh, MPP Halton; Joyce Savoline, MPP Burlington; and Steve Clark, MPP Leeds-Grenville.
- *Have Your Say, Ontario* is a public survey which was recently launched by Tim Hudak and the Ontario PC Caucus. It is the largest survey of its kind in Ontario. The survey asks a series of 54 questions seeking advice on how we can best provide families with real tax relief, focus government on the services that matter most, and how to make Ontario families feel safe and protected in their neighbourhoods.
